Hurricane Evacuation Emergency Preparedness Plan

In the event of an impending hurricane, and at the recommendation of local officials, all short-term volunteers are expected to return to their homes, shortening their time of service. The Per Diem for the remaining days of each volunteer's will be calculated and returned once normal operations have been restored.

Long-term volunteer staff and officials at the School of Urban Missions will maintain communications during an evacuation. In the event of an interruption in telecommunications, information will be disseminated by:

- Manage short- and long-term volunteer team evacuations
 - Assist short-term volunteers in returning home
 - Help long-term volunteers determine best personal evacuation strategy
- Brief Leader on status of short- and long-term volunteers
- Guide return of unused portions of Per Diem money
 - Note date of official SUM evacuation
 - Contact scheduled teams affected by the evacuation, notifying them of the cessation and resumption of normal operations
 - Calculate unused portion of Per Diem money to be returned
 - Track and report sums to be returned to volunteers to business office
 - Keep original copy of tracking sheet
 - Give copies to business office:
 - Bob Hornick: Accountant (controls petty cash and will handle the return Per Diem monies)
 - Mark Tilton: Vice President of Resource & Development

Evacuation Route to Shreveport, LA

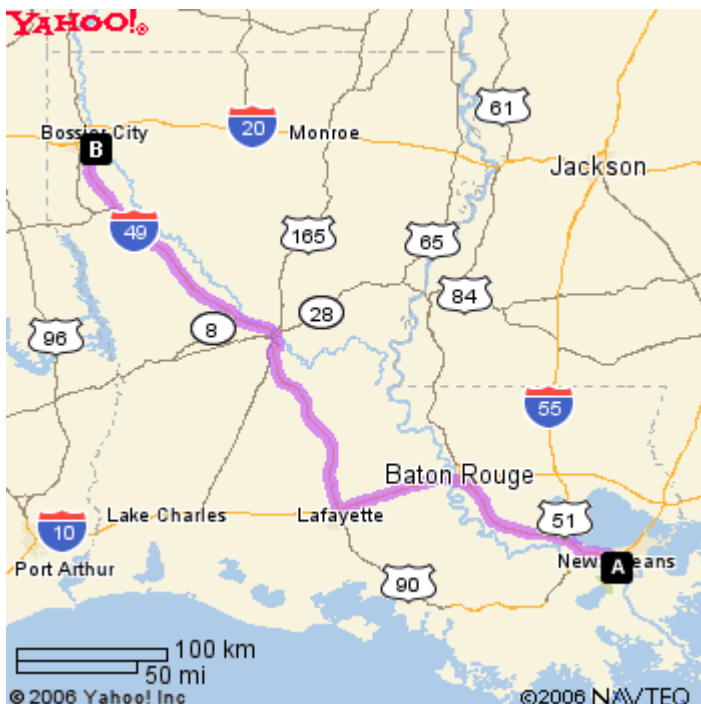
Starting from: **A** 511 Westbank Expy, Gretna, LA 70053-5620

Arriving at: **B** 8925 Youree Dr, Shreveport, LA 71115-3001

Distance: 343.9 miles Approximate Travel Time: 6 hours 12 mins

Your Directions

1. Start at **511 WESTBANK EXPY, GRETNA** going toward **NEWTON ST** - go **0.5** mi
2. Take **L** ramp onto **US-90-BUS EAST** toward **HARVEY CANAL BRIDGE** - go **6.3** mi
3. Merge onto **I-10 WEST** - go **130.1** mi
4. Take exit **#103B** onto **I-49 NORTH** toward **OPELOUSAS** - go **199.5** mi
5. Take exit **#199/LA-526** onto **E BERT KOUNS INDUSTRIAL LOOP EXPY[LA-526]** - go **4.0** mi
6. Turn **R** on **YOUREE DR[LA-1]** - go **2.4** mi
7. Make a U-turn at **LA-523,E FLOURNOY LUCAS RD** onto **YOUREE DR[LA-1]** - go **1.1** mi
8. Arrive at **8925 YOUREE DR, SHREVEPORT**, on the **R**

Your Directions

1. Start at **8925 YOUREE DR[LA-1], SHREVEPORT** going toward **WINTHROP ST** - go **1.3** mi
2. Turn **L** on **E BERT KOUNS INDUSTRIAL LOOP EXPY** - go **3.7** mi
3. Turn **L** onto **I-49 SOUTH** - go **200.0** mi
4. Take the **I-10 EAST** exit toward **BATON ROUGE** - go **130.8** mi
5. Take **L** fork onto **US-90-BUS WEST** toward **SUPERDOME/CLAIBORNE AVE/WESTBANK** - go **5.8** mi
6. Take the **LAFAYETTE** exit onto **WESTBANK EXPY** - go **0.3** mi
7. Arrive at **511 WESTBANK EXPY, GRETNA**, on the **R**
