- A copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or similar document, obtained from the appropriate government agency, for students who completed secondary school in a foreign country. If your college does not have the expertise to evaluate foreign secondary school credentials or chooses not to do so, there are evaluation services available.
- An academic transcript that indicates the student has successfully completed at least a 2-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree
- If State law requires a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), I am providing a copy of that credential for the above listed student
- If State law does not require a homeschooled student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript or the equivalent, signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses the student completed and documents the successful completion of a secondary school education in a homeschool setting
- If the student does not qualify for any of the above options, the student may be permitted to receive Title IV funds by completing an ATB alternative examination with a passing score
