Lead Pastor: In July 2018, we were invited to become the Lead Pastors of First Assembly of God, NPR. This historic multi-cultural church sits on 10 beautiful acres with 3 main structures, a Church, Family Life Center, and Parsonage totaling over 50,000 square feet of ministry space. First Assembly has well over 200 adherents with a yearly budget of over 400,000. As the Lead Pastor, my portfolio includes the preaching, teaching, and discipleship ministry. Team building and training also fits into my job description. Along with these responsibilities I also give oversight to our financial and budget decisions as well as online ministry tasks.

2011-2018

Skypointe Church

Inner-City Wilmington, DE

Lead Pastor and Founder: In 2011, my family and I moved 2,200 miles from our home in Texas to found the first-ever urban Assemblies of God church plant in the city of Wilmington, DE. Since then we have built several ministry teams, organized many city-wide outreaches, and seen the church grow tremendously. Recently we paid forward all of our startup capital (\$20,000) that we received from the PennDel District, and we replenished 100% (\$30,000) of our startup capital to the National Office. Skypointe currently supports 21 A/G missionaries monthly. Our current weekly attendance averages 100 with an annual budget of \$200,000+. Along with my pastoral duties at the church, I also serve as the Assistant-Presbyter of the DelMarva Section.

Student Ministries Director: Responsibilities included all ministries for grades 7-12 as well as some ministry to our college students. We built a leadership team of 30 volunteers, raised almost \$60,000 for Speed the Light, and saw the weekly attendance grow to nearly 200 students. I served as the Sectional Youth Representative of El Paso. I organized several city-wide events including three SEVEN Project outreaches to three public school campuses, a regional Youth Leadership Conference called The Laser Conference, and multiple youth rallies/mission trips. HCC is a church with 2,000 regular attenders and a multi-million-dollar budget. I was responsible for overseeing a budget of about \$55,000 annually.

He has been in full-time Pastoral Ministry for 15 years, serving as a Student Ministry Pastor, Church Planter, and Lead Pastor. Daniel holds a B.A. in Preaching & Evangelism (EU), an M.A. in Christian Leadership (University of Valley Forge), and is currently pursuing a Ph.D. in Leadership with an emphasis in Higher Education at Liberty University. Pastor Daniel's heart and vision is to raise up the next generation of Spirit filled ministers and to see them empowered to become who God has called them to be.
